Proclamation

WHEREAS: FROM THE BIRTH OF TAP DANCING IN OUR FIVE POINTS DISTRICT IN THE 19TH CENTURY TO THE INCREDIBLE CREATIVITY, STRENGTH, AND FLEXIBILITY ON DISPLAY ON COUNTLESS STAGES EVERY NIGHT THROUGHOUT THE FIVE BOROUGHS, NEW YORK CITY HAS ALWAYS BEEN A PREMIER DANCE DESTINATION. AND WITH MORE THAN 200 LANGUAGES SPOKEN ON OUR CITY'S STREETS EVERY DAY, WE ARE ALSO A MELTING POT OF CULTURES. THAT'S WHY THE CITY OF NEW YORK IS PROUD TO HOST THE 4TH ANNUAL DANCE PARADE, AN EXUBERANT SHOWCASE OF MORE THAN 100 ETHNIC AND DANCE CULTURES.

WHEREAS: EVERY YEAR, DANCE AFICIONADOS DELIGHT IN WATCHING THIS EXCITING AND VIBRANT DANCE PARTY WIND ITS WAY FROM MADISON SQUARE TO TOMPKINS SQUARE. 
